

Did ye know?

Kate's engagement ring cost £28,000 when it was bought by Prince Charles for Diana Spencer in 1981. Today the oval 18-carat blue sapphire surrounded by 14 diamonds is priceless! Sales of QVC's look-a-like ring rocketed by 800% on news of the royal engagement.



Clue 19

He'll certainly not find marital bliss at the place where Prince William abandoned comfort to sleep rough in 2009 as part of his role as patron of Centrepoint.



Strike out the place where Prince Andrew served in the 1980s and Prince William underwent training as a search and rescue pilot before being posted to Anglesey.

Did ye know?

During his time with Raleigh International in 2000, Prince William tracked and studied the huemul. This species of deer has been protected in Chile since 1929 and has since been adopted as the national symbol. In 2007, huemul numbers were estimated less than 2000.

Did ye know?

On 29th April 1964. Princess Irene of the **Netherlands married Prince** Carlos Hugo of Spain. The late Oueen Mother was her godmother.

Clue 02

Where did Prince William do his Army Officer Training?

Cross off this world famous military academy.

Did ye know?

Kate's birth name is Catherine Elizabeth Middleton. Often associated with Hecate, the Greek goddess of magic, the name Catherine stems from the Greek adjective 'katharos' meaning pure. Kate is just one of 211 variant forms of the name Catherine!

Clue 03

Flight Lieutenant Wales is stationed in Wales!

The military base where he is stationed in 2010/2011 can also be discounted.

Clue 04

Elminate the town where William's mother once bought sweets for her boys and where Kate has been snapped shopping for champagne.

Clue 05

A firm in China has made commemorative mugs depicting Kate marrying Harry instead of William! This English town has been trusted with producing the official royal wedding pottery.

Did ye know?

When Princess Elizabeth married Lieutenant Philip Mountbatten in 1947, Britain had not yet completely recovered from the devastation of the second world war. The future Queen still required ration coupons to buy the material for her gown!

Clue 06

In 2007, William spent time on duty with The Defence Animal Centre, in a town renowned for its pies, its cheese and also for 'painting the town red'! Cross this town off the map.

Clue 07

Known as the most rebellious town in Devon, this place is also host to a family business awarded the Royal Warrant as the official wheelwrights who maintain the fleet of Royal Carriages.





Clue 08

Strike out the place where William and Kate each paid £100 a week in rent and shared cleaning duties in a two-storey property.

When Prince Charles married Lady Diana Spencer during a lavish wedding ceremony at St. Paul's Cathedral on 29th July 1981, 750 million people tuned in worldwide to watch the couple tie the knot.

Kate might like a RUBY Buckle on her shoes, which when 'unbuckled' will reveal the village where the Middleton family home is situated.

Clue 14

Cross off the place where William and Kate attended their first wedding together as an engaged couple.

Clue 15

Sir Thomas Brock designed the many ornamental street lamps with galleons aloft, that line the processional route of the Royal Wedding along The Mall in London. In 1903, Sir Thomas Brock also built a memorial to commemorate Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee. Cross off where this statue is located.

Clue 16

Where did Prince William's great great great great grandmother die in 1901?

Did ye know?

If Catherine becomes Queen, she will be England's sixth Queen Catherine. The others are Catherine of Valois, Catherine of Aragon, Katherine Howard, Katherine Parr and Catherine of Braganza. Three of these were married to Henry VIII!

Discount the place where Prince William wore wellingtons to play football against a group of salmon fishermen.
