# Instructions

Follow the instructions for each clue and write the answer in the grid provided. Once all the clues have been solved, take the 7 shaded letters and rearrange them to form a word linked to Poldark.

Use this word to complete the following URL:

Enter this address into your browser and the secret will be revealed.

You will need access to the internet to solve the clues, and in particular use the Streetview function in Google Maps. It is important that you follow the precise instructions in the clues to ensure that you are standing in the correct virtual location.



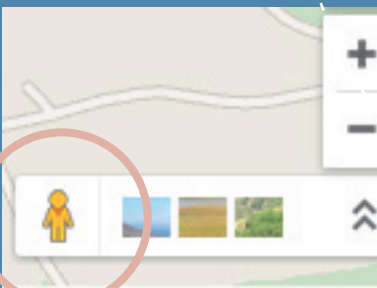
## Clue 1

Go to <https://www.google.co.uk/maps> and enter 'St Breward' in the search box.

In the BBC series, this is where the cottage used as Nampara, Poldark's home is, and some of the miners' cottages were located near here too.

Within Google Maps, pick up your golden 'Google man' (as shown below) and drop him on the road outside the pub.

Follow the road up the hill and go past the church. Stop by the post box and write down what place is six miles away.



## Clue 2

Go to <https://www.google.co.uk/maps> and enter 'Porthcothan' in the search box.

In the BBC series, this place was used to portray Nampara Cove.

Pick up your golden 'Google man' and drop him on the place where the coast path meets the B3276.

To get to Mawgan Porth you go via where?

## Clue 3

Go to <https://www.google.co.uk/maps> and enter 'Levant Mine' in the search box.

In the BBC series, this place was the setting for Tresidder's Rolling Mill.

Pick up your golden 'Google man' and drop him on the National Trust Levant Mine and Beam Engine.

Whose number ends in 1110?

## Clue 4

Go to <https://www.google.co.uk/maps> and enter 'Charlestown' in the search box.

This historic port, a berth for tallships, is regularly seen in the TV series.

Zoom in on the map and pick up your golden 'Google man' and drop him on the blue circle to the left of Antonia's Pearls (the blue circle will only appear once you pick up the 'Google man').

How high in feet is the tide? Enter the number as a word in the answer grid.

## Clue 5

Go to <https://www.google.co.uk/maps> and enter 'Porthgwarra Shop' in the search box.

This cove with its crystal clear waters was where Demelza spied Ross bathing in the BBC series.

Pick up your golden 'Google man' and drop him on the shop. Head towards the telephone box.

What word comes after 'Cove' on the fourth line of the black sign on the fence opposite?

## Clue 6

Go to <https://www.google.co.uk/maps> and enter 'The Parish Church of St Winwaloe' in the search box.

This cove was where they filmed the shipwreck scene in the BBC series.

Pick up your golden 'Google man' and drop him on the road beside the toilets at Winnianton Farm.

On the white sign outside the shop, what is the second word?

## Clue 7

Go to <http://www.st-agnes.com/discover/st-agnes.com-discover-poldark>

What is the second word in the name of the real mine house that is located on St Agnes Head?

With the ruined engine houses set on the cliffs, this area doubled as Nampara Valley during the series.
